These are your first drum grooves in a 6/8 time signature, 1,2,3,4,5,6 - or you can think of it as 3/8 1,2,3 - 1,2,3.  
Try adding fills in 6/8 too, its a nice time signature to play in, enjoy it!

Drum groove 1 and 2. Groove 1 consists of two measures of eighth notes: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6. Groove 2 consists of two measures of eighth notes: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6.

Drum groove 3 and 4. Groove 3 consists of two measures of eighth notes: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6. Groove 4 consists of two measures of eighth notes: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6.

Drum groove 5 and 6. Groove 5 consists of two measures of eighth notes: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6. Groove 6 consists of two measures of eighth notes: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6.

Drum groove 7 and 8. Groove 7 consists of two measures of eighth notes: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6. Groove 8 consists of two measures of eighth notes: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6.

Drum groove 9 and 10. Groove 9 consists of two measures of eighth notes: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6. Groove 10 consists of two measures of eighth notes: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6.

Drum groove 11 and 12. Groove 11 is labeled "Waltz" and consists of two measures of eighth notes: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6. Groove 12 consists of two measures of eighth notes: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6.

Drum groove 13 and 14. Groove 13 consists of two measures of eighth notes: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6. Groove 14 consists of two measures of eighth notes: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6.

Drum groove 15 and 16. Groove 15 consists of two measures of eighth notes: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6. Groove 16 consists of two measures of eighth notes: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6.
